Only one bag of chips left over. — CITIZEN OF THE YEAR: Sue reported she had materials ready to present to the Chamber of Commerce Board at their meeting Oct. 11th, when she would ask for their support of the project and for a board member to join the Citizen of the Year Award Committee. — PANCAKE BREAKFAST: Dean Hammer reported a successful event: 19 Lions worked; 248 served; grossed \$2,371; expences \$1,062 (plus's advertising bill not yet in, estimated at \$95); rebate expected from Krusteez, estimated at \$33.75; approximate net income : \$1,342; sausage (\$347): one box left over that Blaine will keep frozen until next time; St. Mary's instituted a new fee for hall rental: \$250.
